



ANNOUNCEMENT

ORAL EXAMINATIONS FOR DECK AND ENGINE CANDIDATES

1. Oral Examinations Applications for eligibility is open from Monday 13th July, 2026 to Monday, 03rd August, 2026 for both deck and engine candidates and Oral Examinations will be conducted in Dar Es Salaam from Monday **07th September, 2026 to Friday 18th September, 2026** (Exclusive of holidays, Saturday and Sunday);
2. Engine candidates will be examined at TASAC Office, 05th Floor PSSSF Golden Jubilee Towers and Deck candidates will be examined at TASAC Office, 12th Floor PSSSF Golden Jubilee Towers (***Note that, in case of any changes of Oral Examination venue, TASAC will notify the candidates in an ample time***);
3. A candidate seeking to sit for the Oral Examination must submit an application letter together with a duly completed application form, obtainable from the TASAC website (<https://www.tasac.go.tz/>). The application must be submitted at least twenty-one (21) days prior to the scheduled examination date. Upon submission of the application letter, the candidate will be issued an examination number at the registry.
Note: Candidates applying for a second or third attempt and those who postponed are required to submit all required documents to full their application as new applicant;
4. The application shall be accompanied by the relevant supplementary documents specified in the Oral Examination application form and all attachments shall be in orderly manner attached as per list of documents to support oral examination application;
5. Upon being cleared for Oral Examination, on **21st August, 2026** the announcement for eligible candidates will be published, and the candidate will be required to pay appropriate fee for his/her Oral Examination. The schedule date for payment of Oral Examination fee will be **on 24th – 26th August, 2026, and on 28th August, 2026 will be announcement to those who made payments;**
6. Among others, a candidate is required to have appropriate knowledge, understanding and competence of the relevant maritime laws of Tanzania.

A candidate who wishes to postpone or change the date of their oral examination after it has been scheduled, he/she must submit a written request to the Registrar, accompanied by valid supporting evidence, explaining their reasons. This request shall be made at least three working days before the scheduled examination date. Failure to appear for the oral examination at the appointed time and place without a valid excuse may result in automatic failure **(For more information contact us through phone no. 0745 237 548 / 0767491081)**

8. **Important Notice to Observe:**

- i. Oral Examination fee is non-refundable and non-carried forward;
- ii. Failure to observe instructions will lead to disqualification during eligibility;
- iii. No post submission of documents will be permitted after eligibility application deadline;
- iv. All testimonials/supporting documents shall be in colored copies;
- v. Applicants shall attach with other testimonials a sea service calculator accessible online including but not limited to <https://seawallet.co.uk/mca-sea-time-calculator/>
- vi. **Faint/unclear/unreadable attachments will be null and void;**
- vii. Incorrect Statements or Certificates will be considered null and void;
- viii. Fraudulent, erased, or manipulated testimonials shall result in the cancellation, suspension, or revocation of application, and may lead to prosecution;
- ix. For the purpose of eligibility, there will be no communication between applicants and TASAC officers during oral eligibility session until the candidates have been published;
- x. After the publication of the list of eligible candidates, any names or examination numbers not appearing on the list shall be deemed ineligible;
- xi. Submission for appeal shall be within three working days after publication of eligible candidates.
